## MACHINE; Piecing All Levels

Make a Pinwheel block. A little slice and dice. Sew a 9 patch. Done. Super easy. The blocks look like you worked SO HARD on the piecing, but you didn't! Big pieces. Beginner friendly but the experienced piecer will have fun making this pretty quilt.

Featherweights welcome.

#### **SUPPLY LIST**

Sewing Machine (Featherweights and little portable machines are WELCOME).

1/4 in. piecing foot

Neutral thread

BSS (basic sewing supplies- thread snips, pins, seam ripper, etc.)

Rotary cutter (please, put a new blade in it – we will be doing a fair amount of cross cutting in class)

Rotary Mat (we can share)

Ruler 6" x 24" (we can share – DO NOT purchase one if you do not own one this long)

Iron and ironing mat (we can share)

OPTIONAL: cushion for your chair. Ott Light. Sewing chair from home. Portable sewing table from home.

#### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

- FABRIC #I = 42 10-inch squares. Prints. Batiks. Civil War. 30's. Large prints. ALL will work. You can use a Layer Cake where all the fabrics are different and are coordinated to go together. OR Use 21 FQ's from your stash, or purchased to coordinate (you will cut 2 10-inch squares from each FQ). OR raid your stash ALL DIFFERENT fabrics! Or all blues and greens. Or all ONE FABRIC will work too. (<need 3 ½ yds. then cut into 42 10-inch squares.) \*\*NOTE\*\* For Fabric #I Debby used 21 Batik fat quarters from her stash. She cut 2 10-inch squares from each FQ. Each FQ is a different color.
- FABRIC #2 = PLAIN or reads plain. 3 ½ yds. cut into 42 10-inch squares. OR you can use 1 layer cake of LIGHTS. OR all different subtle lights. Or 21 FQs cut into 42 10-in sqs.
   \*\*\*NOTE\*\*\* For Fabric #2 Debby used 3 ½ yds of a soft cream Batik. Cut into 42 10-in. sqs,
- INNER BORDER: PLAIN or reads PLAIN.

  Purchase I yard. Cross cut into II 2 ½ in. strips. \*\*\*NOTE\*\*\* Debby used the EXACT same fabric as FABRIC #2. (3 I/2yds for the blocks + I yd for inner border = 4 ½ yds. total)
- OUTER BORDER: 2 yds. + I yd. for BINDING = 3 yds. total
