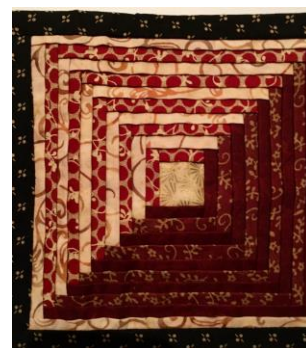
#### Beginner Machine Piecing

This project will have you wondering why you have never before made a miniature quilt. No paper piecing, no stress, just fun! Mary guarantees a finished project and will probably have to throw you out of the classroom for meals. Yes, it IS that much fun.

### Supplies

Book: Folded Log Cabin Quilts by Sarah Kaufman. If not available at your Quilt Shop, it is available at Amazon.

Sewing Machine in good working order. As this project uses a 3/8 inch seam allowance, you will need a regular foot as well as a quarter inch foot. A walking foot is helpful.

In addition to your usual sewing supplies you will need:

Sharp (not universal) machine needles. I prefer Schmetz Microtex™ 80/12.

Small cutting mat, acrylic ruler, and 45mm rotary cutter with a new blade.

Small ironing surface and iron if you have one.

This project uses a lot of thread. It should be neutral or both light and dark to coordinate with your fabrics. For miniatures I prefer a 60 or 80 weight thread. However, 50 weight will do.

### Fabric:

1/4 yd – 1/2 yd cuts of several coordinating fabrics. The sample uses 4 reds, 1 black, at least a yard of a light that is used in each block, and one 1/4 yard of an ACCENT.

The sample uses a light gold. Choose your own fabrics that included a mix of light, medium and dark values. The sample used a yard of another black for the sashing and backing. No batting is needed.
