This classy cardigan jacket is fingertip length, slenderizing in style with a flattering fit. Due to the unique construction, the jacket is also reversible. The seams are exposed to the outside, finished with bias (quilt binding style) creating a totally completed jacket on the inside. Endless creative possibilities can be explored on both the front and back yokes while applying seminole piecing and many decorative techniques to add texture and design to other elements of this "work of art" jacket. Start with a fat quarter of one of your favorite fabrics and build your jacket's color palette from there.

#### Fabric Notes:

<sup>\*</sup> Start with a fat quarter of one of your favorite fabrics and then choose coordinate fabrics from that color wave. This will be used for one of the front yokes.

<sup>\*\*</sup>This fabric needs to be more subtle while still complementing your "focus" fabric.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> This lining fabric should be another equal weight cotton.

- For decorative strip piecing: 1/4 yd. (or scraps) of 5 -7 different coordinating fabrics
- For Seminole piecing décor: fat qtrs.--2 darks & I light **OR** 2 lights & I dark plus a piece for trimming the seminole strip. These should again complement your focus fabric.
- For even more creative endeavors: A variety of decorative trims, cording, ribbons, braids, etc. for further yoke and/or sleeve embellishments. These can be scraps and/or short pieces. (bring fun stuff!)
- Optional: 2 decorative buttons for pockets
