<u>Pattern:</u> \$10.00 payable in class to teacher.

Supplies:

- Sewing Machine (small machines including Featherweights welcome)
- Extension cord/power strip
- BSS (Basic Sewing Supplies: scissors, pins, seam ripper, extra needles, thread snips, etc.)
- Neutral thread
- Prewind several bobbins (so you can be sewing immediately!)
- Ruler (I) with 45 degree marking at least 6" X 12"
- Ruler (2) largest square up ruler you have. Note: Teacher will happily share his rulers, YOU DON'T NEED TO BUY ONE.
- Fabric marking pen
- Iron and an ironing mat (we can share and will have ironing stations around the room)
- Rotary cutter and mat (we can share and will have cutting stations around the room)
- Note taking supplies
- Small paper bag for trash, etc.

Optional:

- Spray sizing (Best press, etc.)
- Sewing chair
- Cushion for your chair
- Personal portable sewing table
- Extra lighting

Fabric Suggestions:

If you purchase the amounts below, you will have more than enough to design a beautiful Attic Windows wall-hanging, maybe even two.

- I yd. scenic, landscape fabric for the glass window pane
- I yd. dark window sill/sash fabric
- I yd. light window sill/sash fabric
- I yd. window lattice (or block sashing) fabric in a dark or medium value; this will also be your first border around the blocks
- I yd. outer border fabric (this may be your darkest sill/sash or you may repeat your lattice fabric after a narrow insert of one of the sill/sash fabrics)

Note: make sure that there is a strong value difference between the sill, sash, and lattice fabrics!
